The Swiss Connection

The army knife, often synonymous with the Swiss Army knife, is a multipurpose tool that has become an icon of utility and smart design. This compact companion is steeped in history, with its origins dating back to the late 19th century.



It all began in 1891 when the Swiss Army decided to procure a new, standardized pocket knife for its soldiers. This knife was intended to be versatile enough to open canned food and disassemble the Swiss service rifle, which required a screwdriver. The first model, called the "Modell 1890," was delivered by the end of the year. It included a blade, a reamer, a can-opener, a screwdriver, and grips made out of dark oak wood, which later evolved into the more durable and hygienic ebony wood.

At the time, Switzerland lacked the capacity to produce the knives in sufficient quantities, so the initial order was placed with Wester & Co. from Solingen, Germany. However, Swiss cutler Karl Elsener, the owner of a company that would later become Victorinox, was not satisfied with this foreign dependence. By 1891, Elsener managed to secure a contract for the Swiss Army and started to produce the Modell 1890 knives in Switzerland.

Victorinox and Wenger

Elsener's company, Victorinox, and its competitor, Wenger, supplied the Swiss Army with knives in the early 20th century. Elsener sought to distinguish his product from his rivals and in 1909 trademarked the term "Swiss Army Knife" for his version. The term is now a registered trademark in many countries. To signify Swiss quality, the knives from Victorinox displayed a white cross on a red shield, while Wenger decorated their knives with a slightly different emblem.

The knives themselves began to evolve. In 1897, Elsener patented a design that included a second spring mechanism allowing for more tools without additional bulk. This design became known as the "Officer' s Knife" and was the precursor to the modern Swiss Army knife we know today.

Global Recognition

American soldiers stationed in Europe bought them in large quantities for their utility and as souvenirs, but had trouble pronouncing the German name "Schweizer Offiziersmesser."
